At KSM what happens if I do the wrong thing? ☹️



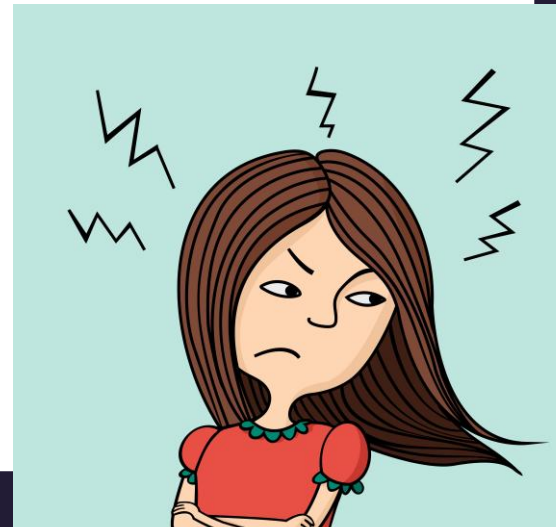
Tier 1 ☹️

- Calling out instead of putting my hand up
- Talking instead of doing my work
- Not starting my work
- Being silly
- Not using the equipment sensibly
- Not doing what the teacher or TA tells you to do



What will happen if you break Tier 1 rules? ☹️

- My teacher or TA will look sad
- They will tell you that you are not doing the right thing
- They will give you a final warning 'this is last chances'
- You will move to another classroom



If you keep on breaking rules, you will move to Tier 2 😞

- Repeated Tier 1 behaviour
- Rudeness to adults
- Refusal to follow instructions
- Disrupting the learning of others
- Leaving the classroom without permission



What will happen if you break Tier 2 rules? ☹️

- Time out in another classroom (10 to 20 minutes)
- Completion of a Reflection Sheet
- 10 to 15 minutes loss of playtime/enrichment
- Class Teacher to telephone parents or carers
- Incident written up on school system
- Miss Waylen, Mrs. Burfoot and Mrs. O'Brien informed

What happens after Tier 2?

You will move to Tier 3 and Tier 4

– not fun 😞

- Removal from class
- Out of class (up to half a day)
- Formal meeting with parents and carers, with Class Teacher and Headteacher
- Implementation or review of a Behaviour Support Plan
- Incident formally recorded as a serious behaviour on the system
