Notice from Wiltshire Police - Raising Awareness of E-Scooter Safety This Christmas

With Christmas approaching, Wiltshire Police are reminding families about the laws and safety concerns surrounding e-scooters, which are increasingly popular gifts for young people. Privately owned e-scooters cannot be used on public roads, pavements, cycle lanes, or parks, they are only legal on private land with the landowner's permission.

Police can seize e-scooters being used illegally, and riders may face warnings, fines, points on a future driving licence, or prosecution. There are also serious safety risks, as some e-scooters can reach speeds of 30mph or more, and riding without a helmet or proper supervision can result in serious injury. Wiltshire Police have already seized over 140 e-scooters this year and are working to keep young people safe. Families are encouraged to talk to their children about these rules to prevent accidents and costly mistakes. For more information, visit Wiltshire Police e-scooter safety.
