Create your own inspired by a beach you have visited, how many different mediums can you include?

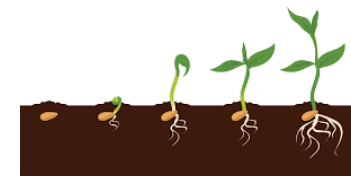


**Science**

Make a mini booklet, making a note of observations and measuring it's growth.

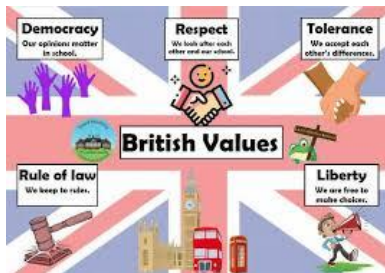
OR
