

Eagles Homework Grid

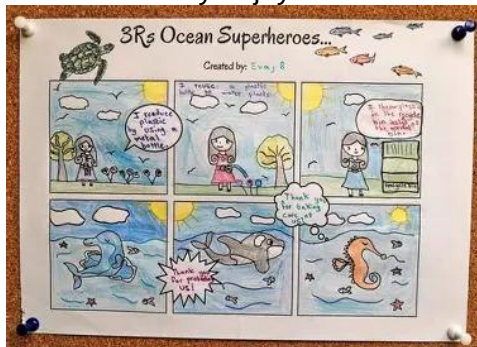
Term 6

You could investigate different soil types in our local area and produce a report.

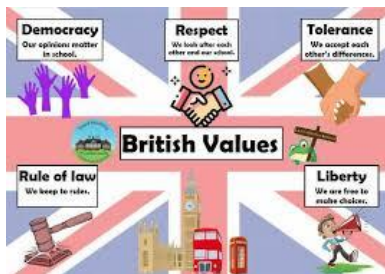
What things grow well here?
