At KSM we have been working really hard to improve school attendance across our school.



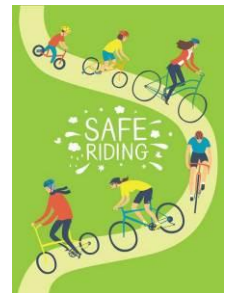
Our attendance is closely monitored by our Education Welfare Officer and the Department for Education. If a child's attendance falls below 95%, a letter will be sent home from the school, with a follow up meeting if required.

Parents and carers are responsible for ensuring their child attends regularly, keeping contact details up to date, and engaging with support where needed. If your child is absent, please contact the school as soon as possible by phone or email, explaining the reason for absence and keeping us informed, wherever possible, appointments should be made outside of school hours. Term-time holidays are rarely authorised and may result in a fine. By working together, we can ensure every child has the best opportunity to succeed.

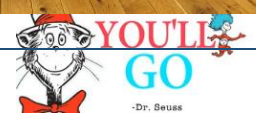
We received the following feedback from the instructors, "the children all did really well, they were polite, respectful and enthusiastic despite the wet weather". Well done everyone we are super proud of you.
