




Autumn Term 2

This interaction happens near the magnetic poles, creating colourful, swirling curtains of light. They are most visible around the Arctic circle. Create your own piece of artwork to show this amazing natural phenomena. You can use any medium you choose but think carefully about your colour choices and the effect your medium has.</p>  	<p>Geography As part of our polar topic we will be looking at similarities and differences between The Arctic Circle and The Antarctic Circle. Create a table to list the similarities and differences that exist between the two poles.
