Tasks

English

Imagine that you are an astronaut who has just had an adventure to space! Can you write a recount of what you saw, where you went and what you did?

In your recount, try to include:

- Where you went
- What you could see
- What the planet was like
- Something exciting that happened
- How you felt

Remember:

- Use your time connectives (First, Then, Next, After that, Finally'.
- Use capital letters and full stops
- Leave a space between your words
- Illustrate your story with a space picture.



Art

Have a look at the artists such as Andy Goldsworthy, Claude Monet and Georgia O'Keeffe. Create a picture of nature or inspired by nature.

You can use:

- Coloured paper
- Paint
- Collage
- Tissue paper
- Fabric
- Printing
- Natural materials (sand, shells, leaves)
- Drawing as well as sticking.



Have fun being creative!

Design Technology

Make a model of a minibeast (or more if you're feeling brave!)

You could use:

- Cardboard
- Egg boxes
- Paper
- Plastic containers
- Recycled materials.



Think about:

- What body parts does your minibeast have?
- How will you join your materials together?
- Can your boat carry a small toy passenger?

History

Create a timeline of different toys.

You can present your timeline in any of these ways:

- Draw some pictures
- Write some facts
- Make a simple poster
- Create a mini fact sheet.

You could try to find out:

- When were the toys first made?
- What are the toys made out of?
- Are the toys handmade or factory made?
- How is the toy played with? Is it different to how you play with your toys?
