- **Comic Strip Creation:** Design a simple comic strip with a beginning, middle, and end, using speech bubbles to show what the superhero and villain say.



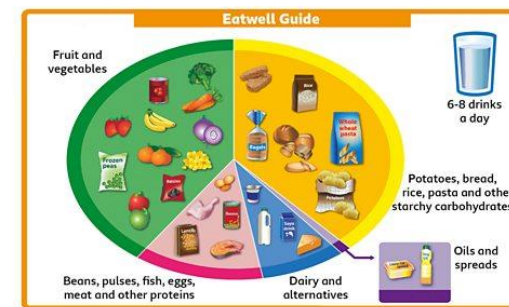
Art
